You will still receive a MONTHLY newsletter, which will be provided to you as a pdf document to read online; then you can decide which, if any, portions you wish to print.

The pdf of the monthly *Connection* newsletter will be sent to member contacts via email; it will also be posted on the Chamber website, with links additional provided via social media and the *E-Connection weekly email blast*.

"We are glad to be able to move in a digital direction with our member communications," said Kellie Goodman Shaffer, Chamber President-CEO. "By providing the newsletter electronically, we will save thousands of sheets of paper each year."

Members who wish to include their own fliers/advertisements in the Chamber newsletter will also reap savings from the changes; your inserts will still be included in the newsletter, but you will simply provide the flier via email for inclusion; the distribution will be increased from approximately 640 copies each month to more than 3,000.

Those who wish to include print fliers in the quarterly publication should note the 2020 deadlines: January 15, April 15, July 15 and October 15.

Those driving through the light display will enter through Gate 4/5 (off Fairgrounds Road then Tiny Town Road) and may tune your radio to Cessna Broadcasting's 1600 AM to enjoy holiday music and event messages.

on the second floor by Headline Marketing & Communications.


There is no charge to attend for all who register by December 5th.




