For example, the Shapiro study reported that "when consumers know that a small business is a member of the Chamber of Commerce, they are 49% more likely to think favorably of that business, and 80% more likely to purchase goods or services from the company in the future."







# Featuring Lunch Keynote by Author Pam Stucky USE COURAGE & CURIOSITY TO TRANSFORM YOUR LIFE

Every day is ripe with possibilities and opportunities, and every day we make choices about whether we will lean into our best lives, our ideal relationships, and our deepest dreams. 



## 2024 AWARDS

The Bedford County Chamber of Commerce is seeking nominees for its 2023 Awards. Recipients will reflect success in business in one or more of these areas: Longevity, Volunteerism, Mentorship, Leadership, Innovation, Community Enhancement, or Overall Excellence (for small, medium or large-sized businesses).

Information provided will be used to characterize the nominees in one or more of these award categories:

- EXCELLENCE IN BUSINESS AWARD (3 Categories): SMALL (No more than 10 employees), MEDIUM (No more than 60 employees) & LARGE (61 or More Employees): Recognizes businesses demonstrating overall stability, a positive public image, and setting an example of community service.
- JOHN ANDERSON AWARD: recognizes a company, organization, group, or individual who have/has enriched the County through an outstanding contribution to the community.
- VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR: recognizes a resident of the Bedford County region of any age who personify the finest spirit of volunteerism by giving generously of themselves to improve the community's quality of life.
- INNOVATION AWARD: recognizes the business which has demonstrated a noteworthy innovation during the past year, such as development and implementation of a new product, service, process or procedure, such as (but not limited to): a new marketing approach, safety, energy efficiency or environmental program, improvement in working conditions, corporate citizenship and/or cost-effective procedures.
- PROPERTY IMPROVEMENT AWARD: recognizes the business which has significantly improved the appearance of its facility through renovation, landscaping, redecorating, etc..
- HERITAGE PRESERVATION AWARD: recognizes the business or organization which has shown a significant commitment to preserving the heritage of Bedford County region.
- EMPLOYER COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD: recognizes the business which has actively supported employee
  participation in volunteer activities that improve the community.
- EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION: recognizes a person, business or organization for their efforts in enriching children, adults and/or the community through learning. For example: heritage awareness, creative arts, workforce development/career exploration, etc. (Honorees may be members of the business community or a member of the educational community.)
- EXCELLENCE IN AGRI-BUSINESS: recognizes a farm or agriculture-related business in the Bedford County region which demonstrates outstanding stewardship of land and livestock, application of technology and/or innovative marketing and civic involvement.

You may specifically recommend nominees for a particular award(s) as described above. Based on the nomination form and follow-up phone interview with the nominee (conducted by the Awards Committee), the Committee may choose to include the individual or business in one or more additional categories.

THIS AWARD REQUIRES A SEPARATE NOMINATION FORM - See the Chamber website to download the form or to use nomination link

ATHENA AWARD: co-sponsored by Thomas Chevrolet Subaru and Bedford Business & Professional Women, recognizes individuals for professional accomplishment, community service, and especially for mentoring women to achieve their full leadership potential. (Due to the secretive nature of the Athena award, these nominees will not be contacted for phone interviews unless also nominated in another category. Rather, the nominator is required to fill out an Athena-specific application.) This application is available for download on the Chamber website or at the Chamber Office.



OUTDOOR POWERSTRIPS, EXTENSION CORDS REQUIRED
 (DO NOT use indoor power strips - they will short out in rain or snow.)

- Each display will be created and built by individual space sponsors (Santa's Elves.) The possibilities to promote your business, club, organization, school, church, etc. are endless! The more the merrier, and we hope to grow this event each year into a major regional holiday attraction! 200+ displays expected in 2024! Returning displays have first right of acceptance of their previous spots.
- For displays: <u>Lights SHOULD be LED</u> (to preserve energy and to ensure that the lights last for many years, saving costs for all!)

- Items left behind after January 31st may be dismantled by the Chamber and/or Fair and materials forfeited.

The Bedford County Chamber Foundation is the 501-c3 educational organization administrated by the Bedford County Chamber of Commerce, and eligible to accept donations through the DCED's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC/EIO) Program.

Founded in 2020, the Foundation presents unique educational programs for students and adults of the Bedford County region. From day one, the flagship program was and remains Leadership Bedford County, a unique 10-month class that allows company representatives to build

relationships and leadership skills while exploring the many facets of our region. More than 330 servant leaders have graduated from the LBC program. Applications will be accepted and interviews scheduled for the class of 2025 beginning in the spring of 2024, with selections announced in July. (The class begins with an August orientation and continues with one (or occasionally 2) meetings per month through June.

Youth Leadership Bedford County is a teenversion of the adult program, designed for 10th graders (applying as freshmen.)



BASICS programming (Businesses and Schools Investing in Cooperative Solutions) has expanded exponentially in recently years, connecting students with the business community and potential future careers in every grade, Pre-K thru 12, and our premier partnership with Allegany College of Maryland adds even greater value to Chamber member businesses, providing ongoing trainings and resources for company enrichment.



Opportunities abound for businesses to invest and take part in our many programs and events provided to area youth, who never pay to participate, making these workforce development opportunities available to any student, regardless of economic circumstances.

Now available – our MVVP program Mission-Vision-Values-Partners, with investment packages supporting all of our

#### **BASICS Programs and Resources**

#### Youth Leadership Bedford County

The mission of Youth Leadership Bedford County is to endow youth with the knowledge and ability to become confident leaders as well as an understanding and appreciation of the business community of Bedford County and the career potentials herein. This ten-month leadership training program for a select group of at least 24 Bedford County high school sophomores consists of team building activities, leadership training sessions, and an awareness of resources, services



and issues specific to Bedford County. This program becomes a pivotal life experience for the participants who will serve in leadership positions today and in the future. A service project is also included as part of the class experience.







#### Youth Leadership Bedford County Summit

Due to the growing number of YLBC applications and students seeking leadership opportunities, an additional Youth Leadership offering was added in 2017 in the form of a county-wide Sophomore Summit, which brings 50 tenthgraders together for interaction with community leaders, team-building challenges, keynote speakers and SWOT

Analysis/Visioning small group exercises, with results provided to county and region leaders for inclusion in the larger strategic planning processes.

All students receive a certificate of completion of the one-day program, in addition to the unforgettable experience.





#### Steps to Success — Enhancing Job Opportunities

Steps to Success, held the last Wednesday of February at the Omni Bedford Springs Resort, is geared toward high school students entering the workforce for the first time. The program focuses on the principals relating to finding a job, keeping a job, being an excellent employee, and learning employee rights and benefits. The program format offers guest speakers, skits, team building activities, games, tours and a job



fair, showcasing an array of careers available in Bedford County. Many of the businesses bring applications or instructions for pursuing positions online, and encourage students to apply for summer or part-time jobs with local companies. In addition, students hone their communication skills through small group interview sessions with local business leaders, Representatives from regional colleges the military are also in attendance to meet with the more than 100 participating students.







#### **Business Community Showcase Career Fair**

The Chamber has expanded its previously-existing Business Community Showcase to now include a morning session designed specifically as a career fair for high school students, and an afternoon middle



school career session for grades 6-8. With more than 50 businesses and organizations exhibiting, including our partners from the Rotary Clubs of Bedford County, we are able to provide a snapshot of our diverse business community for area students, and with it, a look at the many future career opportunities available to them. In addition to booth and table displays, we provide an area for individual professionals to meet with students and discuss their careers. A brief keynote speaker also provides inspiring messages to the students

(e.g. Olympian Natalie Dell, entrepreneur Adam Wiley, PA Secretary of Transportation Leslie Richards, Steelers Quarterback Charlie Batch, PA Representative Jesse Topper and other leaders.)









#### **Educator in the Workplace**

This program is designed to give educators a look inside local businesses. Teachers, counselors and administrators are invited to spend time in unfamiliar environments, from hospitality to manufacturing & distribution. The educators are treated to guided tours with the opportunity to meet business owners, managers and HR professionals, who share the skills and qualities needed by their employees. The lessons learned are then shared with their students as the teachers and administrators prepare future curriculum and other educational offerings.










#### **Agri-Business Career Fair**

One in every seven Pennsylvania jobs is related to agriculture. 






#### **Community Reading Day**





