## PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

Participants in Leadership Bedford County are challenged to explore the current issues facing our community from the vantage point of servant leaders. LBC provides insight as to how Bedford County functions as a community: culturally, socially, politically, economically & educationally.

The concept of LBC is to present participants with all the facts about issues facing our community, including the external forces that affect us. These issues are sometimes controversial; participants develop their own opinions and courses of action.

Leadership Bedford County employs a variety of educational approaches, including lecture, discussion, case studies, self evaluation, team building exercises, site visits, fact finding, and problem solving focused on issues facing our community. Facets of our community that are examined include: history & heritage, education, economic development, arts, recreation, tourism, workforce development, government, the judicial system, human resources, agriculture and more.

Participation in the program is open to individuals residing or working in the Bedford County region. Selection is based on the participants' sincere commitment to serve the community, demonstrated community involvement, and desire to make Bedford County the best place possible to live, work, play and prosper.

As of June 2024, 354 servant leaders have proudly graduated from the Leadership Bedford County program, and are making a difference in our communities!
